

Advanced work notice – working outside of DCO hours under Section 61

Dear Resident,

We are writing to inform you that we have been granted permission **under Section 61 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 to work outside of our approved Development Consent Order working hours** by Broadlands District Council's (BDC) Environmental Health Officer (EHO) to undertake excavation works in your local area.

As part of our ongoing onshore cable installation works for Hornsea 3, we will be working over the weekend, from **Saturday 8 February to Sunday 15 March 2025 8.30am – 5pm**. We don't envisage any incidents, but if there is an unforeseen issue with the works we may need to work beyond these hours.

You may hear some low-level noise from our machinery on site.

We are excavating to install ducts and a joint bay, which includes a ditch, a farmers access road and UKPN low voltage main.

Please note that all our works are subject to site and weather conditions and all the dates in this notification are subject to change.
